

Dear Friends;

I am asking for your support in attempting to set a world record for the world's longest game of kickball. My youth group, PULSE Student Ministries, is teaming with First United Methodist Church and the Pregnancy Care Center of Zephyrhills to raise funds for community mission projects in Zephyrhills and abroad.

The game itself will take place at Krusen Field in Zephyrhills, FL on August 13-14. We will begin at 6 a.m. on Friday morning and completing the game around 11pm Saturday night. We will also be having a World Record celebration Saturday evening at 6 p.m. at Krusen Field. Spectators are welcome throughout the game and vendors will be present for refreshments.

Your donation will go toward assisting women who are in crisis pregnancies, community service projects and other mission opportunities in Gulf Shores, MS and Park City, MT. Every dollar you donate will be directly applied to help myself and my group, serve others and share the love of Jesus.

There are multiple ways to give and any gift would be greatly appreciated.

**One Time Gift:** You can choose to give a one-time gift to help myself and my group, serve others.

**Hourly Rate Gift:** Another option is to give based on how many hours we play. The current world record is 36 hours and we will be attempting to play 40 straight hours of kickball. If you choose to give an hourly pledge then the amount you pledge per hour will be multiplied by total hours played to get your total gift.

Ex. A pledge of \$2 per hour would be \$80 if we complete all 40 hours of the game.

**World Record Gift:** You could also choose to give a gift based on whether or not I set the world record. This gift would only be given if we were to set the world record.

This gift can be combined with the Hourly Rate Gift. For instance, you could pledge \$1 per hour with a bonus of \$20 if we break the record. This would give you a total gift of \$60.
